TUITION AGREEMENTS

Mrs. Soares has made phone calls to all families that had not signed the tuition agreement in School Admin. There are still contracts that have not been signed. **You need to go in and sign your agreement in order for us to start your payments.** **If need be, I will be calling individuals myself!**

WARM WEATHER UNIFORM

All students are now allowed to wear shorts. Reminder: shorts must be appropriate length and ankle socks must be worn.

REMINDER

It is that time of year when I start looking at tuition balances. **All** financial obligations need to be paid by June 1st. Our students who are in 8th grade, kindergarten and pre-k will not take part in graduation, end of year activities if there is any money owed to the school and report cards will not go home to any student with an outstanding balance. Presently I have \$58,350.00 in tuition that is outstanding. This equals one payroll for my teachers and assistants. **It is vital for my working budget to collect this money by June 1st. Payroll needs to be met.** This does not include extended care, homework club or lunches which also has a current outstanding balance of \$9,850.00.

Fr. Bob's Weekly Reflection

We can hardly believe the message from this week's gospel. It is one of complete invitation to us. Jesus tells us of his intimate bond with the Father and invites us into the same kind of close relationship with Jesus himself.

He does not promise us a trouble-free life, and is clear about the challenges we will face as his followers. He cautions us that the world will want to make us one of "its own" and Jesus lovingly protests that we are his, not the world's. He prays to the Father of us, "they are your gift to me. I wish that where I am they also may be with me..."

This kind of loving dialogue with the Father is what Jesus wants with us. It does not mean our lives will be trouble-free but we are offered the peace in our hearts that Jesus longs to give us.

Some days we may feel anything but peace in our hearts. That is the time to pause and open our hands and our hearts to the Lord. Just the simple physical act of opening our hands can send a signal to our hearts. We can stop thinking and start feeling the love that Jesus has for us.

We can begin each morning at the side of our beds, aware of the sacredness of the day ahead of us, and ask for peace, courage and guidance. On our way to work or while taking care of our family, cooking or running errands, we can stop for the briefest moment and ask again: "Lord, help me to feel how much you love me. Help me to accept that love and carry it to all those you send into my life today."

And at the end of the day, we can pause again at the side of our bed, reflect for a moment on our day and offer thanks for the moments where we felt in our hearts the love of Jesus. And, we can ask that tomorrow we can feel the Lord's own love and compassion for us - and beg that we can pass that along.

Like Peter in Friday's gospel, we have denied Jesus many times in our lives but he looks at us again with love and simply says, "Follow me."

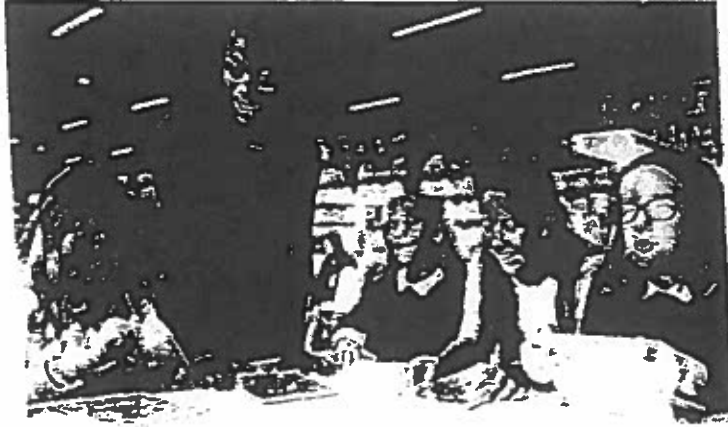


New CORI Procedures

- All volunteers must now complete two online Safe Environment Trainings, which must be renewed every six years. (Informational flyer is attached.)
- Once both trainings are completed, you must print out BOTH certificates and turn them into the school office. Once we receive both certificates you will then be given a CORI background form to fill out, which must now be done in the office. Please bring a photo ID so that we may make a copy of it, to be sent in with your CORI renewal form. This still must be done on a yearly basis for all volunteers.
- If you live in RI, you must also complete a disclaimer form and have it notarized. We will also have to copy your photo ID to go along with this form.
- If you live or have lived in any other states, besides MA or RI, within the past 5 years, you must then complete a background check, online, through the CMGConnect website.
- NO person will be allowed to volunteer with our students until they have met the requirements of a CORI check and completion of the Safe Environment Training that is online at CMGConnect. There will be NO EXCEPTIONS allowed to this policy so that we can be assured we are both in compliance with the law and more importantly, we are doing everything to protect the children in our care.

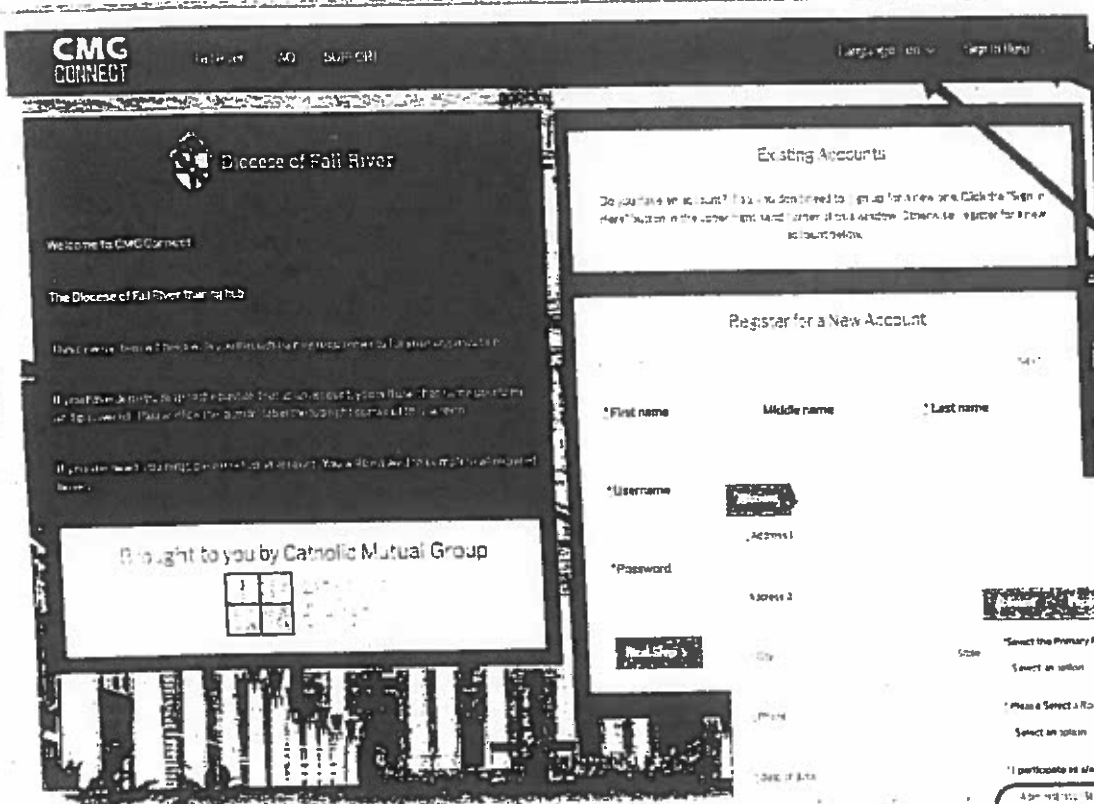
Safe Environment Training

Getting Started:

1. Go to <https://fallriver.cmgconnect.org/>
2. Create a new account by completing all the boxes under "Register for a New Account." This includes address, primary parish, and how you participate at your parish or school. If you have questions please contact your parish/school coordinator.
3. Your main learning dashboard will show you all of the requirements and optional training curriculums that have been customized for your particular role within the Diocese.
4. Click 'Start Curriculum' for the Safe Environment Training.
5. Once training is completed, you can access your completion certificate by returning to the training dashboard and clicking 'Download Certificate'.

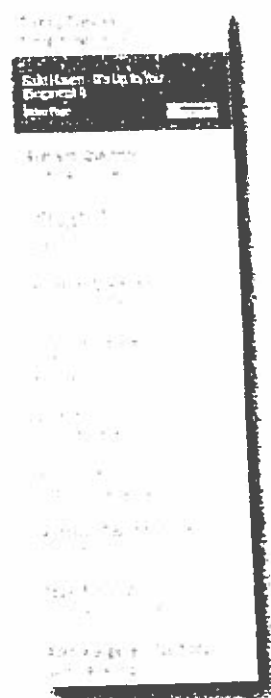
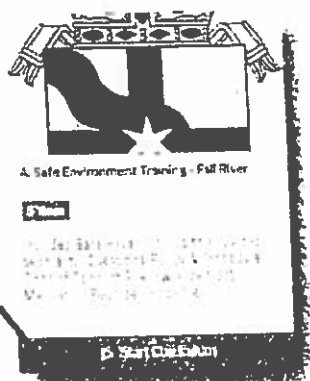
• You will progress through ALL three account creation screens before your registration is complete. *If you are unsure of what role to select for your participation category, please contact the diocese.*

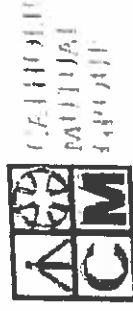
