Fr. Bob's Weekly Reflection

This is potentially a powerful week for entering into how available Jesus is for us. He promises to be with us, to make us one with him, even to make his home in us. He promises to keep us safe and to bring us to our true home to be with him forever. The opportunity we have this week is to accept this offer of deepening our relationship with our Lord. We accept it if we let his availability to us seep more and more deeply into our consciousness each day. We do this by beginning each day focusing our first thoughts of the day in a simple recognition that we are not alone: "Thank you for this day, Lord. I know you want to stay close to me, to guide me and support me today. I need some real strength and courage to face some of the challenges of this day. Help me to keep connecting with you throughout this day, to remember your presence and love." This 20 second prayer will open our day to a Lord who invites us to surrender our troubles to him.

At various times of the day - especially when we approach a particularly challenging responsibility, or an occasion or situation in which we habitually lose our peace or give in to temptation - we can be renewed by another 20 second prayer. Each time we turn to the Lord, our "moment of connection" can become more specific, more intimate, and more confident. If we find ourselves sidetracked and distracted all day, or for several days, it is easy to get right back on track by pausing, while doing almost anything, and asking our Lord to remind us of his constant presence. We will quickly return to a sense that Jesus knows us, understands us, and wants to be with us in whatever troubles our hearts. And, each night, when we give thanks to our Lord for his fidelity to us throughout the day, we will be given the grace to know, again, that we are never alone.



Dear Diocese of Fall River families,

We are writing to let you know about an exciting initiative across the Diocese. Last year, a School Wellness Committee was created, consisting of a small group of staff and administration whose focus is on improving the health and well-being of our students and staff. The role of this committee includes: collecting and assessing health-related data, developing goals and creating a Diocesan action plan. This action plan will include the development and creation of policies and programs to improve the health of our students and staff.

Given this is a new initiative for the Diocese, the first step in this project is data collection. To date, the Diocese has not collected health-related information from students and parents in a formal, systematic way. The data captured will be used to develop an action plan with relevant and necessary programs and policies across the Diocese.

Over the past several months, the Wellness Committee has created a series of online surveys for students and parents, which ask a variety of health-related questions such as nutrition, physical activity, school culture, mental health and so on. Students across grades 3-12 will complete one survey (online at school) between April 22-May 3, 2024. Parent surveys will follow at a later date this Fall.

All student surveys are optional, confidential and anonymous. If you do not wish to have your child participate in the survey, please complete, sign and return the attached Opt-Out Form to your school no later than Monday, April 22nd.

A printed copy of the surveys is available for viewing at each school upon request. We are so excited to take this first step in identifying our strengths and areas of growth. The Diocese of Fall River School Wellness Committee is conducting a very important project to learn more about health behaviors among Diocesan school students.
